Subject :- Medical re-imbusement to pensioners-option for fixed medical allowance-Simplification of procedure to be followed.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Punjab Government letter No.4330-5HBV481/18,453 dated the 10th November, 1981, on the subject noted above and to say that Punjab Government pensioners except members of All India Services and retired Judges of Punjab and Haryana High Court, were allowed to exercise options to claim fixed medical allowance at Rs. 10 p. m. alongwith their pensions, within a period of three months i.e. upto 10th February, 1982, provided they had not claimed any reimbursement during the month with effect from which options were to be exercised. Some applications seeking certain clarification and asking for extention in the date of exercise of options were received. Government reconsidered these representation and have decided as follows--

(i) Pensioners settled in Punjab, who draw their pensions from the treasuries within the State may send their options to the Civil Surgeons concerned, who will forward the same to the treasuries Accountant General, Punjab/ the scheduled bank etc. from where they draw their pensions.

(ii) Pensioner settled in Chandigarh may send their options to the Heads of Departments, concerned, who in turn will forward the same to the Punjab Treasury at Chandigarh /Accountant-General, Punjab/scheduled banks etc.

(iii) Pensioners settled out of the State of Punjab, should send their options to their Heads of Departments who will forward the same to the Accountant-General concerned or the treasuries/scheduled banks etc. from where they draw their pensions.

2. It has also been decided that pensioners who could not exercise their options earlier, may do so now within a period of two months from the date of issue of these orders.

3. It is further, clarified that in future, pensioners may exercise their options within three months of their retirement in the same manner as the existing pensioners.

4. This issues in concurrence with the Department of Finance, vide their U.O.No.1413-6 FD(1)-82, dated 12th, 19th April, 1982.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Punjab Govt. Letter No. 10/12(66)87-5HBV/10036, dated the 2nd June, 1988 vide which a procedure was laid down for the drawl of fixed Medical Allowance through the pay and Accounts Office, Punjab New Delhi by the Pensioners residing at Delhi and New Delhi and drawing their pension through this agency, The Pay and Account Office, Punjab, New Delhi brought to the notice of the Govt. that the pensioners residing at Delhi/New Delhi drawing their pension from the Pay and Accounts Office, New Delhi who opted for fixed medical allowance prior to issuance of these instructions are not covered in these instructions. After careful consideration the State Govt. have now decided to allow the pensioners residing At Delhi and drawing their pension through Pay and Accounts Office, Delhi who had opted for fixed medical allowance prior to the 2nd June, 1988, to receive the payment of fixed medical allowance also through the Pay and Accounts Office, New Delhi, in future with effect from the 1st February, 1989.

2. As regards the payment of fixed medical allowance for the past period for which they had given option the matter is also under consideration separately.

Subject :- Grant of free medical facilities to Punjab Govt. pensioners and their dependants- Fixed Medical Allowance and reimbursement on account of cost of Spectacles.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to Punjab Government Order No. 10/12(4) 86-3HBV/19897, dated 28 September, 1989 (copy enclosed), vide which the decisions of the Government to treat Pensioners at par with serving employees, with regard to medical facilities and to allow them reimbursement of cost of spectacles upto Rs. 75/- (Rupees Seventy five only) once in every five years were conveyed. The above decisions have been made effective from 1st July, 1989.

Fixed Medical Allowance

2. In accordance with the above decision, the President of India is pleased to convey that the rate of fixed medical allowance to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners shall stand revised to Rs. 30/- per month with effect from 1st July, 1989. The pensioners/Family Pensioners shall be given a fresh option for getting fixed medical allowance or reimbursement of expenses of domiciliary treatment, exercisable within a period of four months from the date of issue of this letter. Options will be exercised in accordance with procedure laid down in Punjab Government circular/letter No. 8388-5HBV-81/6320, dated 23rd April, 1982, which is reproduced as under :-

- (i) Pensioners settled in Punjab, who draw their pensions from the treasuries within the State may send their options to the Civil Surgeons concerned, who will forward the same to the treasuries/accountant General, Punjab/the scheduled banks etc. from where they draw their Pensions.
- (ii) Pensioners settled in Chandigarh may send their options to the Heads of Departments, concerned, who in turn will forward the same to the Punjab Treasury at Chandigarh/Accountant-General, Punjab/ Scheduled banks etc.
- (iii) Pensioners settled out of the State of Punjab, should send their options to their Heads of Departments who will forward the same to the Accountant General concerned of the treasuries/scheduled banks etc. from where they draw their pensions.
- (iv) The pensioners should not have claimed medical reimbursement during the month with effect from which option is to be exercised.

The arrear on account of fixed medical allowance will be paid on receipt of options. This issues with the concurrence by the Department of Finance conveyed *vide* its I.D. No. 1/34/88-IFP-III, 1st December, 1989.

Reimbursement of cost of spectacles

3. Regarding reimbursement of cost of spectacles, the following points are clarified :

- (i) This facility is available to all Pensioners irrespective of the fact whether they are claiming fixed medical allowance or open medical reimbursement.

- (ii) The Pensioner desiring of claiming reimbursement of this account will submit an application, accompanied by cash memo, regarding purchase of spectacle, to the authority who is competent to allow him medical reimbursement (i. e. the Civil Surgeon concerned incase Pensioners drawing pension in Punjab and Head of Department concerned in the case or other Pensioners.) He will make it clear in the application he is claiming reimbursement on this account on the first time or he has not claimed reimbursement on this account during the last five years.
- (iii) The concerned authority will issue necessary sanction allowing reimbursement of the amount subject to a maximum of Rs. 75/- (Rupees Seventy Five only, and it will be indicated in the sanction that the concerned Pensioners have certified that they have not claimed any reimbursement on this account earlier by during last five years. The date of purchase of spectacle, as shown in the cash memo, will also be shown in the sanction against each name.
- (iv) The expenditure on this account will be debited to the same head of account, from which medical reimbursement is paid.
- (v) All existing Pensioners can avail of this facility immediately, irrespective of the date or their becoming Pensioners.
- (vi) The period of five years, where after reimbursement on this account can be claimed against will be accounted from the date of purchase of spectacle, i. e. if one purchase spectacle on 1st December, 1989, he will be eligible for claiming reimbursement against for this purpose only after 1st December, 1994.

Subject:- Grant of free medical facilities to Punjab Govt. Pensioners and their dependents fixed Medical Allowance.

Sir,

With reference to Punjab Govt. Instructions issued vide letter No. 10/12(4) 86-3HBV/19897 dated 29th Sept., 1989 and No. 10/12(4) 86-3 HBV/25073, dated 4th December, 1989 on the subject noted above, I am directed to say that various pensioners Associations have raised certain points for clarification in respect of fixed Medical Allowance. The matter has been considered in detail and the following clarifications are given :-

- (i) The pensioners who have been drawing fixed medical allowance @ Rs. 10/- P.M. and who want to continue this facility shall get fixed medical allowance @ Rs. 30/- P.M. w.e.f. 1st July, 1989 without exercising fresh option.
 - (ii) The pensioners who have been drawing fixed medical allowance but who now want to opt. out. may give fresh option within a period of four months from 4th December, 1989. Such options (in duplicate) shall be submitted by them to the Treasury Scheduled Bank from where they are drawing their pensions. The Treasury/Scheduled Bank in turn will forward one copy of the same to the Civil Surgeon in respect of pensioners who are drawing their pensions from the Treasuries/banks within the State and to the Heads of the Departments in respect of pensioners who are drawing their pensions at Chandigarh/out of the State of Punjab. The Treasury/Bank concerned will record a certificate to the effect that the pensioner has not been paid fixed medical allowance for the month from which option has been exercised.
 - (iii) The pensioners who were not drawing fixed medical allowance but who now have opted will opt within four months from 4th December, 1989, for this facility, shall get fixed medical allowance @ Rs. 30/- per month w.e.f. 1st July, 1989 or from the first of any subsequent month, provided they have not claimed any medical reimbursement on account of outdoor treatment from that date. Therefore the concerned Civil surgeon/Head of Deptt., as the case may be, shall give certificate to this effect to the Bank/Treasury concerned.
2. These clarification may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned.

Subject :- Reimbursement of Medical Claims/grant of fixed Allowance to Punjab Government employees, pensioners and their entitled dependants.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to Punjab Government circular letters No.9220-5HBI-78/22699 dated 28th June, 1978 No. 4330-5HBV-81/18453 dated 10th November, 1981 and No.3789.5HBV-82/14593, dated 17th September, 1982,-vide which facility of fixed Medical allowance was granted to Punjab Government Employees/Pensioners (including retired members of All India Services and retired judges of the Punjab & Haryana High Court) and their entitled dependants Certain Punjab Government Departments have sought clarification as to what would be position, in case where both husband and wife are either State Government employees or working under the different Governments, Semi Government Departments, Government Under-takings, Public undertaking and Corporations etc. The State Government have given due thought to the points raised by the various Departments and clarify as under---

- (i) When both husband/wife are working under the State Government they both are entitled for fixed Medical Allowance being not dependant on each other with entitlement of free treatment/reimbursement of Medical charges as indoor patients.
- (ii) When one of them is serving under the State Government and other is serving under the other State/Central Government Organisation, Public Undertaking etc. they both are entitled for fixed Medical Allowance according to the Rules/instructions of their respective Government/undertakings, not being dependant on each other.
- (iii) When husband is drawing fixed medical allowance under the State Government it is open to the wife to claim open re-imbusement only for herself, but cannot claim reimbursement in respect of other entitled dependants because of the fact that the husband is claiming fixed Medical allowance.
- (iv) When wife is claiming fixed medical allowance it is open to husband to claim open reimbursement for himself and for his entitled dependants:
- (v) When the pensioner is claiming fixed medical allowance he cannot claim open reimbursement for himself/herself and for his entited dependants with entitlement of Free treatment/ reimbursement of medical charges as indoor patient for himself and for his entitled dependants;
- (vi) Option for fixed medical allowanc, once exercised, will be final and irrecoverable and is cannot be withdrawn/changed at any state.

I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to convey that the President of India is pleased to enhance the rate of fixed Medical allowance from Rs. 30 P.M. to Rs. 40 P.M. for those pensioners/families who opt for getting fixed medical allowance w.e.f. 1st May, 1990.

Subject :- Imposition of ceiling on claims for medical reimbursement of Government employees/pensioners other than claiming fixed medical allowance.

Sir

I am directed to refer to Punjab Government circular letter No. 10005-6/19-82/10162 dated the 7th October, 1952 *vide* which the State Government employees governed by Punjab Civil services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1940 subject to certain conditions, were allowed to claim reimbursement for the cost of medicines prescribed by their authorised Medical Attendants which were not available in the hospital/dispensary and had, therefore, to be purchased by them from the market as outdoor patients.

2. After due consideration, the Government have now decided to impose a ceiling of Rs. 1,000 (Rs. one thousand two hundred only) per annum on the reimbursement to Government employees/pensioners of the cost of medicines prescribed by the Authorised Medical Attendants, which are not available in the hospital/dispensary and have, therefore to be purchased from the market as outdoor patients.

3. However, a list of chronic ailments and procedure for the certification of these ailments will be notified separately. The employees/pensioners and their dependants suffering from these chronic ailments will be exempted from the above ceiling. The exemption, however, will not be admissible to employees-pensioners who are getting fixed Medical Allowance.

4. Fresh options may be given by the Govt. employees/pensioners who had opted for open medical reimbursement in the past but now want to opt for fixed medical allowance. These options may be given within two months from the issue of these instructions.

5. These instructions will be in force w.e.f. 1st of December, 1990 onwards. A proportionate ceiling of Rs. 400 has been imposed w.e.f. 1st December 1990 to the end of the current financial year i.e., 31st March, 1991.

6. This issues in consonance with the decisions taken in Finance Department and conveyed *vide* their I.D. No. 7/8/90-5FBI, dated 5th September, 1990 and I.D. No. 6/158/FEII/89 dated 27th September, 1990.

I am directed to invite attention to Punjab Government circular letter No. 10/12(90)88-5-HBV/30042, dated 29th November, 1990 on the subject noted above vide which it had been decided that the employees/pensioners who may be willing to draw fixed medical allowance may give their options within a period of two months from the date of issue of the letter under reference Government had been extending the period for options allowed under the existing policy for the grant of fixed medical allowance to its pensioners from time to time. This policy resulted in debarring those pensioners who reside outside the State of Punjab to avail of this facility because they did not get proper knowledge of all such instructions intime. Representations continued to be received from the pensioners associations for extending date of submitting the options After careful consideration of all these problems. Government have decided that the pensioners are at liberty to submit their options for the grant of fixed medical allowance at will. Therefore, there will be no Time Bound options criteria in respect of pensioners.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to this Department's communications 1. No. 580-SHBV 84/1153, dated 14th February, 1984, 2. No. 7/245/5HBV-84/11057-60, dated 22nd June, 1984 noted in the margin, *vide* which it was decided that the widows of pensioners should have the option to get fixed medical allowance of Rs. 10 per month like the Government employees/pensioners in lieu of outdoor medical treatment of themselves and their entitled dependents. They could exercise their option in this regard upto 31st July, 1984. A widow would start drawing fixed medical allowance from the first of the month following the date of option provided she had not claimed any reimbursement for the treatment obtained by her as outdoor patient during the month in which option had been exercised. The representations have been received from the Association of pensioners and individual pensioners requesting for grant of benefit of cash medical allowance to widows of pensioners. Now it has further been decided that the widows of Pensioners and their entitled dependents (the definition of 'Family' as contained in Rule 6.17 of the Punjab Civil Service. Rules, Volume-II, for the purpose of granting medical benefits to the pensioners) shall have the option to get fixed medical allowance of Rs. 10 p.m. like the Government employees/pensioners in lieu of outdoor medical treatment of themselves and their entitled dependents.

2. As regards procedure to be followed for the submission of options, attention is invited the Punjab Government letter No. 8388-5HBV-81/6320, dated 23rd April, 1982 and No. 7(4)- 83-5HBV-14662, dated 26th August, 1983 and instruction contained therein will also apply mutatis mutandis

I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Fourth Punjab Pay Commission, on the subject cited above, the Governor of Punjab, keeping in view the Government's commitment to the welfare of its employees and Pensioners, is pleased to grant a fixed Medical Allowance of Rs. 250/- per month instead of Rs. 150/- per month as recommended by the pay Commission to all eligible Government employees/pensioners on a uniform basis with effect from 1-1-1998, without any option. There shall be no reimbursement for outdoor treatment at all with effect from and after 1-1-1998. Accordingly, it is clarified that in respect of employees/pensioners, who had not earlier opted for fixed medical allowance, bills for reimbursement may be entertained for the medicines purchased before the 1st January, 1998. The facility for reimbursement of expenditure on indoor treatment, however, shall continue as heretofore.

I am directed to say that it has been brought to the notice of the State Government that retired officers of All India Services, are not being paid fixed medical allowance of Rs.250 per mensem from 1st January, 1998. The Government have considered this matter and it is clarified that retired officers of all India Services (including retired officers of IPS/IFS) belonging to Punjab cadre and their wives/husbands, who after retirement have settled in Punjab/Chandigarh and draw their pension through Punjab Government Treasuries, are entitled to get fixed medical allowance at the rate of Rs.250 per mensem with effect from 1st January, 1998 in accordance with the conditions as contained in Government letter No.5/22/97-1FPI/11179, dated the 31st December, 1997.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Punjab Govt. Letter No. 7 (4)83-5HBV/14662, dated 26th August, 1983 vide which a detailed procedure for drawal of fixed medical allowance from treasuries situated in the Punjab State/ Chandigarh and one situated out of audit jurisdiction of A.G. Punjab at Delhi was laid down. The pay and Accounts Office of Govt. of Punjab has started functioning at Delhi w.e.f. 1-1-1986 for making payments of pension etc. to the Punjab Govt. pensioners residing at Delhi. It has now been decided that the Punjab Govt. pensioners drawing their pension from the pay and Accounts Office at Delhi may also draw payments of Fixed Medical Allowance through this agency. They may submit their options in this connection to their concerned Departments from where they were retired. The concerned Departments will forward the options of these pensioners to the Pay and Accounts Office, Punjab Government, New Delhi under intimation to the Reserve Bank of India, New Delhi/ Accountant General (A & E), Punjab, Chandigarh, and the concerned Public Sector Banks etc.

2. The Punjab Govt. pensioners residing at Delhi/ New Delhi desirous of exercising this option (Who have not already opted) may do so within 3 months from the date of issue of this letter. A pensioner will start drawing fixed medical allowance from the first of the month following date of option revised he has not claimed any reimbursement during the month in which option has been exercised.

A copy is forwarded to the Director, Health and Family welfare, Punjab, Chandigarh for taking necessary action with regard to the amendment of the Punjab Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1940.
